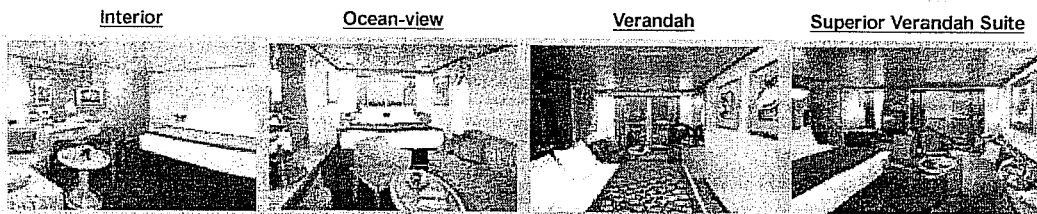


CLARK COUNTY HISTORICAL MUSEUM'S ALASKA CRUISE

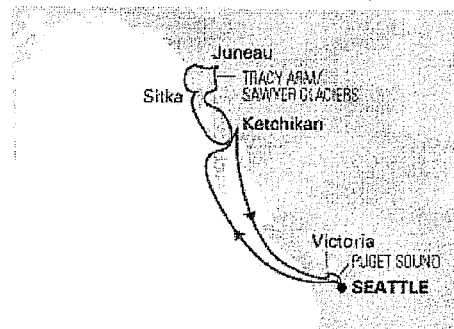

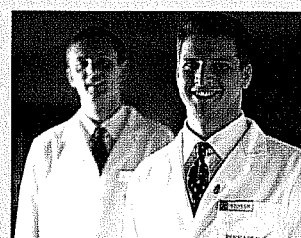
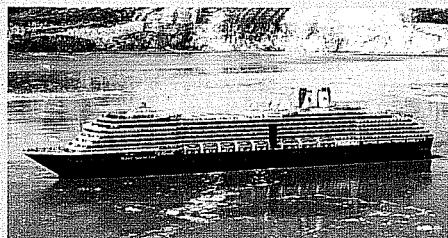
